



2018 General Election Student Voting Guide

How to Vote in the General Election on November 6, 2018

1

Are you voting in the North Dakota election?

- a. Yes – go to step 3
- b. No, I'm voting in my home state – go to step 2

For out of state residents, Google “absentee ballot” plus the name of your state (i.e., absentee ballot Minnesota) and follow the steps provided by your state government.

Are you voting in person or by absentee/mail?

- a. Voting in person – go to step 4
- b. Absentee/Mail – Go to this link and follow the instructions provided to get your absentee ballot:

To vote in person, you'll need valid North Dakota driver's license, nondriver's identification card, tribal government issued identification, or long term care identification certificate that includes your name, current North Dakota residential address, and date of birth.

If your valid form of identification doesn't include your current North Dakota residential address or date of birth, you can supplement it with a current utility bill, a current bank statement, a paycheck, or a check issued by federal, state, local, or tribal government.

- You can also update the address associated with your North Dakota driver's license online. If you do that, you won't need any documentation to prove your current address. However, make sure you change it at least 30 days prior to voting. Please go to this link to do so:
