CLTCC's Student Government Association (SGA) is responsible for governing student interests, advocating for student concerns, providing support and recognition for recognized student organizations, and serving students by hosting activities and events that enhance student life.

Student government is an excellent leadership training experience, which makes it a great addition to any academic or professional resume. Being a member of the student government is a great opportunity to meet new people and make long lasting relationships with a diverse group of students.

Additionally, all SGA Officer positions are paid. Any student at CLTCC is eligible to run for election to the SGA, so long as they meet the eligibility requirements:

- Must be taking a minimum of 12 credit hours in the academic semester during which they are running for election, and each semester while in office.
- Possess and maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.50
