- Two letters of recommendation from faculty, staff, or administrative members
- 15 signatures of Appointed Representatives who support you running for your position
 - A signature sheet will be provided. This is the only acceptable form for signatures
 - Your intended position must be clearly printed at the top of each signature page. Should your intended position change, you will be required to obtain another 15 signatures on a new signature sheet.
- A one-page essay on your purpose for running (12-point font, single spaced)
- A completed Chair Application

All candidates must be fulltime Flagler College students with a minimum GPA of a 2.0. A fulltime Flagler College student is enrolled in 12 credit hours or more per semester. This information will be verified through the Office of the Registrar. Due to time management conflicts, any candidate will not be permitted to participate in the Student Judiciary Council. If you are a Resident Advisor or serve on the Campus Activities Board, you will be qualified to run on a case by case basis.

When you apply for this position, you are stating your intent to serve for one (1) full academic year.

Rules and Regulations of the 2016-2017 SGA Election

- 1. The Election Packet is due no later than Friday, April 15th, at 4:00pm to Mr. Tim Mellon.
- 2. All candidates will be notified of their qualification at 5:00pm on Friday, April 15th, 2016.
- 3. The entire Election Board will review allegations of smear campaigning. If found guilty, a candidate will be disqualified immediately.
 - a. Please note that you are responsible for your campaign team members as well. If one is caught smearing another candidate, you will be held accountable.
- 4. Candidate may not spend any money on the Election or campaign.
- 5. Candidates will give a five (5) minute speech at the General Assembly meeting on Tuesday, April 19th, 2016 as to why they should be elected to their position.
 - a. After all the candidates have spoken, Appointed Representatives will vote on the candidate that they believe to be the most qualified for the position.
- 6. After the meeting, the Election Board and the SGA Advisor will tally the results from the election.
- 7. Candidates will be notified on Wednesday, April 20th, 2016 at 5:00pm of the results.
- 8. In the case of a runoff, Appointed Representatives will be emailed an election survey on Wednesday, April 20th, 2016 which will close at 4:00pm that day.
 - a. The results will be emailed out at 5:00pm on Wednesday, April 20th, 2016.
- 9. Failure to comply with any of the prior mentioned rules and regulations will result in a candidate's disqualification.
- 10. If a candidate is disqualified, they will be given a letter stating the charges against them. They will then have 24 hours to appeal to the Vice President for Student Services. After reviewing the evidence, and talking to the Election Chairs, the Vice President for Student

Services will make the decision on whether or not the candidate should be allowed back into the election.
