**Official Statement of Position**  
**2019-2020 LEGISLATIVE PLATFORM**

The Florida College System Student Government Association (FCSSGA) represents approximately 800,000 students at 28 Florida State Colleges comprised of 70 campuses statewide. The following legislative platform planks were selected by the 2019 – 2020 FCSSGA State Executive Board and approved at the FCSSGA State Presidents' Assembly on September 21, 2019. The positions within the planks were decided by a majority vote of voting delegates of the FCSSGA.

**1. College Affordability**

- FCSSGA supports HB 55 Sunshine Scholarship Program
- FCSSGA supports SB 66 Student Loans and Scholarship Obligations of Health Care Practitioners
- FCSSGA supports SB 188 Student Eligibility Requirements for State Financial Aid Awards and Tuition Assistance Grants

**2. Opportunities & Resources for Florida College System Students**

- FCSSGA supports HB 251 Students Participating in Intercollegiate Athletics
- FCSSGA supports HB 287 Postsecondary Student Athletes

**3. Campus Safety and Security**

- FCSSGA supports HB 117 Concealed Weapons or Concealed Firearms Licensing
- FCSSGA does not support HB 273 Carrying of Firearms
- FCSSGA does not support HB 6001 Licenses to Carry Concealed Weapons or Firearms
- FCSSGA does not support HB 6003 Firearms
