

## Campaign and Financial Guidelines

### Rules and Regulations:

- Candidates can put up posters, banners, and handbills.
  - Campaign materials cannot be posted on any doors, windows or glass walls and must adhere to campus posting policies.
  - No campaign materials are allowed in the parking lots, especially on or in cars.
  - Candidates are responsible for the cleanup of campaign materials after the election
- It is suggested that the candidates refrain from any mudslinging or slander in connection with the election of any of the candidates, officials, or Student Life staff.
- Candidates will not falsify any information on the application or campaign materials.
- Campaign funds shall be limited to spending a maximum of \$150.00 per candidate. This amount shall include all personal funds as well as donations and contributions.
  - Candidates must keep all receipts in order for the election committee to verify campaign spending.
- During voting, no campaign material is to be within 100 feet of any polling booth in any direction. The election committee will measure off the 100 feet.
- During voting, no person shall attempt to influence verbally, physically, psychologically or in any subtle or otherwise insidious manner, any persons in or around the voting booths, specifically within 100 feet in any direction of said booths.
- Results will be verified by 5pm on **APRIL 30, 2021**. Announcement of the winners will be posted on the Student Life window and the Student Life webpage. Candidates will also receive an email.

### Online Election Voting Dates:

Online polls will open at 8 a.m. on April 28th and close at 11:59pm on April 29th. All currently enrolled students will receive an email with directions to the online voting site and a link to the Candidate Voting Guide.
