I will conduct myself in a respectable and appropriate manner in any action, on or off-campus, pertaining to the AWC election process/selection process.

The following pertain only to the *election* process:

- Publicity (including but not limited to) signs, decorations, flyers, and electronic media, **WILL NOT** be distributed or posted before the week before the election.
- All publicity must be approved by the Student Leadership and Activities Coordinator.
- You may only hang publicity on bulletin boards or concrete surfaces. Any publicity that is hung on the following surfaces will be considered a violation.
 - Painted or drywall surfaces
 - Doors or windows
 - Campus signs or mirrors
 - Vending machines
- Each candidate cannot exceed a total \$50 for all of their publicity costs (including donations).
- Each candidate will be responsible for removing their own publicity from the campus and properly disposing of said material by following the election.
- No campaigning or campaign materials allowed in the building where voting is taking place.

The following is included in the *election and selection* processes:

- Each candidate will receive 15 signatures from the student body signifying their confidence in the candidate's abilities to serve the greater student population.

Any violations of the above policies will result in termination of your candidacy. Please sign below if you fully understand and are willing to comply with the policies.

Minimum Qualifications:

- A candidate for any position must be a fully enrolled student at AWC during the term of his/her office.
- A candidate must not currently be on or be put on academic probation during his/her term of office.
- A candidate must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- A candidate must not have officially graduated from AWC or any other accredited higher education institution.
- If chosen in any position of responsibility you are held to a higher standard, as a result your behavior on or off campus are subject to review. If you accept this position, you need to agree to the Code of Conduct.
- Must attend mandatory leadership trainings in the Fall and Spring
