### TIMELINE

#### Election Timeline

- January 13 (first day of spring semester) - Candidacy application made available
- 2 Officially Scheduled and Public Rules Readings to be held in the student government office (CSU 273)
  - Thursday, February 20<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM
  - Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM
  - Further rules readings can be set up for individuals and parties by contacting the Elections Commission Chair at [Hunter.Brings@mnsu.edu](mailto:Hunter.Brings@mnsu.edu)
  - Rules readings are no longer required, but may be requested if questions arise
- March 27 – Campaigning Begins
  - Candidates may begin to hang posters and utilize social media
- March 31 – Filing deadline for Presidential and Vice Presidential Candidates
- April 7 – Filing deadline for all other Candidates (Senate and Boards)
- April 8 – Presidential and Vice Presidential Forum (and Fee Increase Open Forum, if necessary)
  - Will be held via Zoom and starts at 12:00 PM

- April 14 – April 16 Election
  - Voting open from 8:00 A.M. on Tuesday, April 14-6 p.m. on Thursday, April 16 at [www.mnsu.edu/voting](http://www.mnsu.edu/voting)
- April 18– All campaign materials must be removed.
