College Affordability

- FCSSGA will oppose any bills and/or laws that will limit bachelor degree programs and courses within the Florida College System.
 - Post-Secondary Education
 - Senate Bill 374 (Opposed)
- FCSSGA will oppose any bills and/or laws that limit access to students who qualify by current law and are seeking to attend the Florida College System.
 - Post-Secondary Education Tuition and Fee Waivers
 - Senate Bill 82 (Opposed)
- FCSSGA will oppose any bills and/or laws requires students within the Florida College System with excess credits to an excess charge of 100% tuition on top of the tuition costs.
 - Excess Credit Hours Surcharge
 - House Bill 153 (Opposed)
- FCSSGA will support any bills and/or laws that provide Bright Future funding for Florida College System students who attend classes during the summer semesters.

 - House Bill 155 (In Favor)

Safety & Security

- FCSSGA will oppose any bills and/or laws that will allow for open carry weapon use on the Florida College System campuses.
 - Openly Carrying a Handgun
 - Senate Bill 140 (Opposed)
- FCSSGA will oppose any bills and/or laws that will allow for breached in sensitive personal information form not being disclosed to the students whose information is potentially threatened.
 - Public Records and Public Meetings/Information Technology/Postsecondary Education Institutions
 - Senate Bill 110 (Opposed)

Social Issues

- FCSSGA will support any bills and/or laws that would remove taxes from the purchase of feminine hygiene products.
