Position: *Delegate*

Constitutional Duties:

1. Has one vote in the Student Government Association (SGA) Full Session and SGA Congress.

Additional Duties:

- 1. Be aware of current issues and student opinion regarding Castleton.
- 2. Serve on and/or chair assigned number of Congress committees and report to the Congress on committee meetings and issues.
- 3. Serve on assigned SGA or College committees and report to the Congress on committee meetings and issues.
- 4. Research and recommend legislation.
- 5. Maintain a minimum of three (3) office hours per week.
- 6. Attend all regularly scheduled and special Congress meetings, SGA Full meetings, and Student/Community forums.
- 7. Attend SGA orientation/leadership training event each semester.
- 8. File all necessary paperwork.
- 9. Other mutually agreed upon assignments and responsibilities.

Duties and Powers of Elected Officers:

- 1. To initiate and act upon legislation for the general welfare of the membership of the SGA.
- 2. To investigate and act upon all policies and procedures which affect the membership of the SGA.
- 3. To act upon proposed changes of all committees under the jurisdiction of the SGA.
- 4. To partake on committees to aid in the congressional process.

Qualifications:

- 1. A matriculated student at Castleton registered for eight (8) or more credits.
- In good academic standing (30 credits or less, 1.75 GPA; 31 credits and above, 2.00 GPA)
- 3. Have completed at least 27 academic credit hours at time of candidacy.
- 4. Have completed at least one semester as a full-time student at this campus.

Term of Office:

This is an elected position. The term of office runs from the day after Commencement until the Commencement of the following year.
