STUDENT GOVERNING ASSOCIATION

The Student Governing Association (SGA) Intern Program is an opportunity for new students to learn about the SGA process. Interns serve in various capacities throughout the three branches of the SGA. Interns work on SGA projects, serve on Student Senate Standing Committees, participate in the student judicial system, and have senators as mentors.

HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?

Step 1: SGA Intern Program applications are available June through the first week of September.

Step 2: Applications are due to the Office of Student Activities and Services (OSAS) by the first week of September.

Step 3: Interviews are then conducted by the Student Senate Vice Chairperson, Senate Operations Chairperson, and Intern Coordinator.

Step 4: Approximately 20 interns are selected for the Intern Program by mid-September.

WHAT WILL I DO AS AN INTERN?

- Attend Student Senate meetings.
- Work on projects.
- Work closely with a current Student Senator.
- Be appointed to a Student Senate Standing Committee where you will have both speaking and voting privileges.

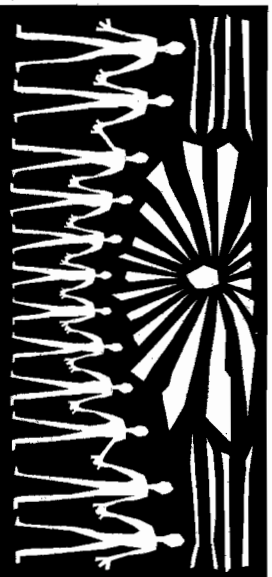

Promote student ideas within federal, state, and local governments.

PRIVILEGE FEE

Responsible for review of the student fees totaling over \$8 million a year.

SENATE OPERATIONS

Responsible for constitutional revisions and review of senate legislation.

Concerned with all areas of student life.
