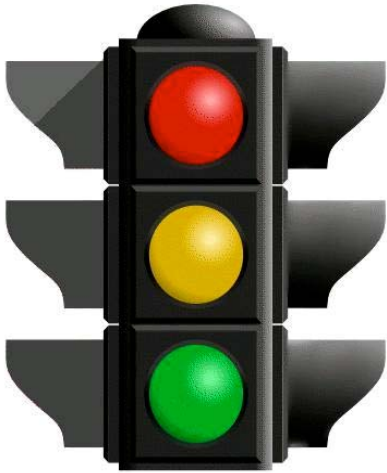


## The Traffic Court



The Traffic Court consists of five justices. One justice serves as the Chief Justice and another serves as the Associate Chief Justice of the court. The Student Traffic Court shall hear all non moving traffic violations i.e. parking tickets.

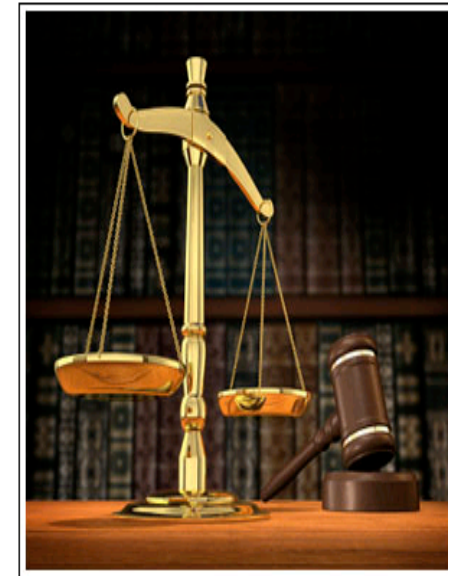
The associate justices of the Student Traffic Court can be reached in the Student Government Association building. Our office hours are Monday-Friday from 11:00am until 5:00pm.

# How To: Appeal a Traffic Ticket



## Level One: Parking Services

A parking ticket must be appealed within five (5) working days of the date a citation has been issued, an appeal must be made in writing on the approved appeal form. The appellant must present the ticket in which they choose to appeal. Appeals can be made at the parking services building. Your right to appeal will be forfeited after the five (5) working days from the date the ticket was issued.

The first level of appeals will be reviewed by the Director of Parking Services. Once the appeal is received the director of parking services has fifteen (15) business days to determine whether the appellant is innocent or guilty. Once the decision has been made the appellant will be notified via mail in writing of the decision.

## Level Two: Student Traffic Court

If an appellant is dissatisfied with the decision made at the level one hearing they have the option of appealing to the Student Traffic Court.

An appellant must appeal for level two within ten (10) working days of the decision of the first appeal. After appealing for a level two hearing the appellant will be informed three (3) business days prior to their hearing. All decisions made by the Student Traffic court are final.

Appellants to the Student Traffic Court are allowed to produce any evidence i.e. pictures, video, documents, etc to defend their case. Student Traffic court is held on alternating Tuesdays from 7:15pm until all cases are heard. If a student is unable to meet on their scheduled hearing date they may reschedule for the following Tuesday.
