GPSA Requirements

Pursuant to the ASASU constitution, to be eligible as a GPSA candidate, one must: Executive Officers or members of the Assembly may serve only if registered for at least one (1) credit hour of graduate or professional academic credit at Arizona State University in the current regular semester and in good academic standing as defined by the University for that student's program of study. The candidate is responsible for ensuring his or her own academic status with the registrar.

USG Requirements

Students seeking elected positions in USG must meet the following qualifications at the time of declaring candidacy and maintain the qualifications throughout term of office:

- a) Must be a member of USG (see USG Elections Code).
- b) Must be a degree-seeking student at ASU.
- c) Must be a student in good academic standing with ASU.
- d) Must be a student in good disciplinary standing with ASU.
- e) Must be a student enrolled in and maintain at least 6 credit hours per semester on the campus where the position exists; overall, student should be enrolled in seven (7) credit hours to be completed within the time span of a full semester at Arizona State University
- f) May only hold one office within USG concurrently (including appointed/hired positions).

The Elections Department will confirm your eligibility after reviewing all required documents.
