Alcohol/Illegal Drugs

No member of the student organization shall take part in acts that are illegal and/or abusive as it relates to alcohol and drugs and/or activities that violate the rules of ATSU. If any member is found participating in such acts, we, the members, reserve the right to take all necessary actions to correct this behavior for the betterment of the organization.

The possession, use, and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages during any organization event, any event that an observer would associate with the University, or in any situation sponsored or endorsed by the organization, must be in compliance with any and all applicable laws, policies, and regulations of the state, county, city, and ATSU. The unlawful possession, sale and/or use of any illegal drugs or controlled substances at any organization-sponsored event, or at any event that an observer would associate with the organization, is strictly prohibited. The organization shall not use or condone the use of alcoholic beverages/illegal drugs as part of their membership intake recruitment or education programs.

Hazing

No member of the student organization shall take part in hazing activities, and if any member is found participating in such acts, we, the members, reserve the right to take all necessary actions to correct this behavior for the betterment of the organization.

Hazing activities are defined as (but not limited to): any action taken or situation created, intentionally, whether on or off organization premises or during organization functions, to produce mental or physical discomfort, embarrassment, harassment, or ridicule.

Transportation and Travel

Members of the student organization shall strictly obey all applicable motor vehicle laws and rules of ATSU as it relates to transportation. Operators will ensure that vehicles are not overloaded and are driven in a safe manner. Rental vehicles shall be operated in accordance with rental contracts.

Sexual Harassment/Abuse

Members of the student organization strictly prohibit the act of sexual harassment/abuse discrimination, in any form. No member shall take part in activities deemed sexual harassment and/or abuse discrimination, and if any member is found participating in such acts, we, the members, reserve the right to take all necessary actions to correct this behavior for the betterment of the organization.

The organization will not tolerate or condone any form of abusive or discriminatory behavior on the part of its members, whether physical, mental, or emotional in respect to sex, race, ethnicity, physical or emotional handicap, age, marital status, or sexual orientation. This includes any actions not limited to sexual assault, verbal harassment, or deemed demeaning to all.

Required Advisor Agreement

Advising a student organization is an exciting opportunity to interact with ATSU students outside of the classroom setting. An advisor-advisee relationship is one that impacts students' lives on a different level and gives students the opportunity to get to know a faculty/staff member in a different capacity.

The role of an advisor will vary in some degree between organizations. As organizations vary in their expectation and needs, it is important that you develop an understanding with the organization as to the nature of your involvement. While an advisor and organization should agree on a set of expectations for one another, the following are expectations the Department of Student Affairs will have of the advisor:

- Be available to the officers and/or members of the student organization for advising and required signing of documents (e.g., financial statements, annual activity reports, etc.).
- Assist both the old and new leadership in transitioning to ensure historical continuity.
- Attend any student organization event held off-campus and/or outside of business hours on campus.
- Obtain signature authority on all financial-related student organization accounts.
- Ensure the student organization properly re-registers each academic year and submits authorized representative forms, as updates are needed.
- Meet with the duly elected or appointed organization leadership and members, as determined by the organizations constitution, as appropriate
- Allow the duly elected or appointed organization leadership to exercise primary decision-making authority with regards to the student organization's goals, objectives, and activities within limitations of expectations.

Definitions

Interest Group

A group of students with an interest in a particular cause or topic that is generally academic in nature. Interest groups are required to register with the Department of Student Affairs and may use university facilities. Interest groups are not required to have a constitution or by-laws but are encouraged to have them on file for organizational continuity. Interest groups may not collect funds.

Registered Student Organizations

A registered student organization provides students with opportunities to expand and support professional, personal interests; build relationships; develop skills and experiences; allow personal growth; and engage in campus/local/global communities. Registered student organizations are required to register with the Department of Student Affairs and have both constitution/bylaw and a full-time ATSU employee advisor.

Sponsored Student Organizations

A registered student organization provides students with opportunities to expand and support professional, personal interests; build relationships; develop skills and experiences; allow personal growth; and engage in campus/local/global communities. Sponsored student organizations are officially sponsored by the University. Currently sponsored student organization status is reserved exclusively for the Arizona, Missouri student government association's and the University Student Association.
