## Alfred University Student Senate Elections Petition & Information Packet

## Vice Presidential Candidate

Thank you for your interest in the Alfred University Student Senate! Enclosed in this packet you will find enough sheets necessary for soliciting 150 signatures from the student body at Alfred University. There are certain responsibilities which the Vice President must fulfill. As a candidate, you are required to know those responsibilities. It is encouraged that you review the current Student Senate constitution. If you have any questions about the elections process or what you are responsible for, please contact a Senate Executive Board Member or email senate@alfred.edu.

Below you will find the rules and deadlines for the election.

## **Guidelines:**

- 1. All full time undergraduate and graduate students in good standing with the University are eligible to run for executive offices.
- 2. You must submit a minimum of 150 valid signatures with ID numbers in order to have your name placed on the ballot. All full and part-time undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to sign your petition **once**, and may sign as many candidate petitions as they wish.
  - \*You are not permitted to solicit signatures door-to-door in any residence hall.
  - \*All signatures must be valid and legible in order to be counted.
  - \*No student shall sign more than once on a single petition.
- **3.** Campaigning for an office shall begin after all candidates have met with the Elections Committee regarding the rules and guidelines for the elections process.
- **4.** You are allotted a maximum of \$25 from Student Senate funds for publicity. No other funds may be used. Funding is to be used for campaign materials only. These funds will be made available to you upon verification of your petition.

## **Important Deadlines:**

- 1. Election packets are due to the Student Senate advisor, Tricia Debertolis, at the Center for Student Involvement in the Powell Campus Center no later than four PM on Tuesday during the third week of the Spring semester. The chair of the elections committee will contact all eligible candidates by email by Tuesday night.
- 2. Your presence will be mandatory at the Student Senate meeting during the third week of the Spring Semester so that you are informed of the rules and guidelines of the election process.
- **3.** Your presence will be requested, though not required, at *Meet the Candidates* night during the fourth week of the Spring Semester.
- **4.** The election will be held one minute past twelve o'clock AM Sunday to twelve o'clock AM Wednesday during the fifth week of the Spring semester.
- **5.** The winners will be announced on Wednesday during the fifth week of the Spring semester at the Student Senate meeting
