- Bake Sales
- Candy Sales ~ best are lollipops (can make them yourself) or contact national companies which already have the products to sell as a fundraiser
- Coupon Books/Discount Card Sales ~ national, regional & local companies that offer discounts for products, entertaining and dining. Also, try to work with local companies to create your own discount cards.
