Article IV, Section 1: SGA Risk Management Policy

The following policy must be adhered to at all SGA sponsored and cosponsored events.

- 1) No SGAT funds will be allotted for the purchase of alcohol at SGA sponsored or cosponsored events.
- 2) Only beer and nonfortified wine will be served by a contracted proprietor.
- 3) The sponsors/cosponsors will provide alternate beverages throughout the event. The sponsors will also provide food that will be available throughout the event.
- 4) No alcohol may be brought into the event, from the outside, by anyone attending the event. Violation of this clause will result in expulsion from the event.
- 5) Alcohol service will be discontinued:
 - a) One hour prior to the end of the event.
 - b) To any individual who is obviously intoxicated.
 - c) To any individual displaying either anti-social or aggressive behavior.
 - d) At the discretion of the contracted proprietor

It shall be the responsibility of the Social Committee to ensure that a contract is let to licensed proprietor as designated per contract
