Discrimination and Harassment Policy

The Office of Student Life has a zero tolerance policy for any acts of discrimination. Any enrolled ACC student will be given access to Student Life programs or activities and shall not be limited on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, age, gender, sexual orientation, political affiliation, or disability. All recognized clubs/organizations will comply with the American with Disabilities Act of 1990 and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 when recruiting members for their club/organization.

ACC policy states that any activities that could be described as harassment are prohibited. This harassment could be on the basis of gender, ethnicity, national origin, religion, disability, or any other characteristic. Any student who believes they have been subject to harassment and/or believe they have been discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, national origin, age, gender, sexual orientation, political affiliation, or disability, and students who believe they have been denied any accommodation to which they are entitled should report this matter, in writing, to the Student Life director.

When planning an event, student groups must plan a welcoming environment to all students that is free of discrimination and any harm. This includes accessibility to all areas.
