

The rule enforcement process is a vehicle through which campaign committees can work to resolve differences among themselves. It is not designed to be an offensive process, but rather a method to ensure as much as possible that candidate pairs do not gain an advantage over others through unauthorized means. An infraction should be filed only when campaign committees cannot resolve the issue on their own. Consequences are designed to promote fairness, not retribution.
