
The Beacon College Conduct Process

*Supersedes all other disciplinary procedures





At any time during the Conduct Process, a student may be removed from the campus or housing when the health, safety, or welfare of the college community or student is at risk. In all Conduct matters, the College adheres to a preponderance of the evidence as the standard for burden of proof. In exceptional circumstances, the college President or his/her designee may suspend any student whose presence is believed to be contrary to the best interests of the college community. If student fails to attend a Judicial Committee Meeting or Conference; student is automatically found responsible, is notified of sanctions, and fined \$50. All conduct matters are handled exclusively with the accused student. Students may seek assistance from members of the college community during Judicial Committee Hearings or with written appeals only.
