Q: Could you please explain how the HVAC system works in

A: Adjusting the thermostat in the New Residence Hall In the NRH the system will either heat or cool your room to the temperature you set on your thermostat. The base temperature setting for each room is 72 degrees for cooling and 68 degrees for heating and the thermostat may be adjusted up or down a maximum of 5 degrees in increments of 1 degree.

- 1. Press either the up or down button to open the adjustment
- 2. Use the up or down button to raise or lower the desired space temperature settings.
- 3. Press the X button to return to the main display screen.
