What's happening with the cell phones in the NRH?

"We certainly wish reception could be better for everyone. An outside contractor installed a repeater system to rebroadcast outside cell signals inside the NRH. The outside signal strength for T-Mobile, Verizon and Sprint is approximately 94db, which is borderline for outside calls – a loss of 2db's bringing the signal inside is not sufficient for inside calls. AT&T and carriers who use AT&T towers (i.e. TracFone) work great inside the building since the tower is only ½ mile distant. Before we suggest everyone migrate to AT&T we are looking for one more independent engineer to help us analyze the situation."
