The Student Activity Fee allows the Contra Costa College Associated Students (student government) to provide funding for campus clubs, events, activities, and campus based programs that will benefit the student population. Examples of programs in which the activity fee could support are student scholarships, textbook scholarships, multi-cultural campus events, community resource outreach programs.

## **Refund Process and Deadline:**

The Student Activity Fee is voluntary. In order to receive a refund of the Student Activity Fee, you must complete this form and turn it into the Cashier's Office located in the Student Services Center.

Refund forms must be received within the first two weeks of instruction for a full semester class, or before 10% of the class time for a short-term class. No refunds will be processed after that time. Refunds will be issued monthly after the first two weeks of instruction each semester.

If the student's account has no outstanding (unpaid) fees, a refund check will be mailed to the student's address on file in the college Admissions Office. If you have a new address, please notify the Admissions Office at the time of withdrawal. If the student has outstanding (unpaid) fees, the refund will be applied as a credit to their student account.
