As a potential candidate, you will be required to complete certain forms and documents to validate your candidacy, which are listed below:

- Complete the **online** candidate application by **5pm, Friday, May 17th, 2013**.
 - o Applications are available on SGA's OrgSync page under the 'Forms' tab at **orgsync.depaul.edu**.
- Attain **at least 100** signatures on the attached petition, which also needs to be turned in to the Office of Student Involvement by **5pm, Friday, May 17th, 2013**.
 - o OSI in Lincoln Park is located in Suite 201 of the Lincoln Park Student Center.
 - o OSI in the Loop is located in Suite 11027 of the DePaul Center.
- A hard copy of any and all campaign materials (including but not limited to print materials, Facebook sites, handbills, etc.) needs to be turned into the Lincoln Park Office of Student Involvement **immediately upon posting**. Please remember to follow all flyer posting rules when posting print materials around campus. An electronic link of any electronic campaign materials needs to be sent to the EOB Chair **immediately upon posting**. You can contact me at **cgoodpa2@depaul.edu**.
