Expectations (Homecoming Queen)

Dyersburg State Homecoming Queen is sponsored by the Student Government Association (SGA) and is a student leader that represents the College as a Student Ambassador. The following is expected of all Student Ambassadors:

- 1. You are expected to be enrolled full-time (minimum 12 hours per semester) during the academic year and maintain satisfactory academic progress. Ambassadors placed on probation or suspension may no longer be eligible to serve as Ambassadors.
- 2. You are expected to carry yourself in a professional manner at all times. You are always representing Dyersburg State Community College on and off campus.
- 3. You are required to show up for assignments on time and in the proper attire. If you are unable to work an assignment, it is your responsibility to provide notification in advance.
- 4. You are required to attend all meetings of the Student Government Association at the campus where enrolled, and other meetings as assigned.
- 5. Some assignments may be more enjoyable than others; however, the expectations is that you work all assignments with the same enthusiasm.
- 6. If a problem arises in your assignment, or you have been placed in an uncomfortable situation; you are to report the incident to the Student Government Association Advisor as soon as possible.
- 7. You are expected to promote and participate in student activities, in an effort to encourage other DSCC students to participate in the campus community.
