

Guidelines for Student Organization Web Pages

- I. Content
 - A. The Student Organization Constitution (and Bylaws) must be included on the Organizations website and must be publicly accessible.
 - B. All web pages must stylistically look well and adhere to each organization's identity. (i.e. use complimentary colors, don't mix too many fonts, etc)
 - C. All web pages must have a disclaimer at the footer of every page*
 - D. Each page should also have the logo of the Organization (if available)

- II. Policies
 - A. While the College makes no effort to pre-approve, review or edit organizational web pages, it reserves the right to remove pages that it, in its sole discretion, deems inappropriate.
 - B. In order to be linked from the official LVC web site, Student Organization web sites must be housed on the LVC server.

- III. Maintenance
 - A. A web site that is more than one academic year out-of-date will be hidden from public access on the main College web site.
