## Jobs Descriptions: SGA President's Cabinet

**The Student Body President** provides leadership to the entire student body, and represents student's concerns and suggestions to faculty, administration and trustees. The President also provides leadership to all of the cabinet as well as the South Side Café.

The Student Body Vice President serves as Election Coordinator when it comes to President's Cabinet and Peer Review Board elections. The Vice President serves as chairperson of the Student Forum and plans and moderates all of their meetings. The VP also ensures Student Forum committees operate efficiently and effectively.

The Vice President of Organizations works with the clubs and organizations on campus that receive funding from SGA, making sure that they are planning activities and doing things as an organization that reflects their mission as a club and the mission of Messiah College. The Vice President of Organizations also helps other clubs on campus in getting through the process of becoming chartered with SGA.

**The Vice President of Finance's** job is to work with chartered and executive clubs and organizations on campus with financial planning, budgeting and operations to facilitate fiscally responsible use of Student Government's available funds.

The Vice President of Educational Programs is responsible for issues relating to academic life and diversity. There is a program within SGA that provides a partial grant to students eligible to present at conferences with a faculty member. The VP of Educational Programs is also chair of the Multicultural Council, a role within SGA that is essential to ensuring the voices of students from underrepresented racial and ethnic populations are heard.

The Chair of the Peer Review Board works with students to reconcile those on campus who have broken the Community Covenant. The Chair also assists in solving issues related to the Presidential Cabinet.

**The Executive Secretary** records minutes of Student Forum meetings and informs the student body via the SGA bulletin board. The Secretary also assists other co-members of the President's Cabinet to accomplish goals efficiently.
