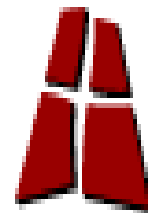

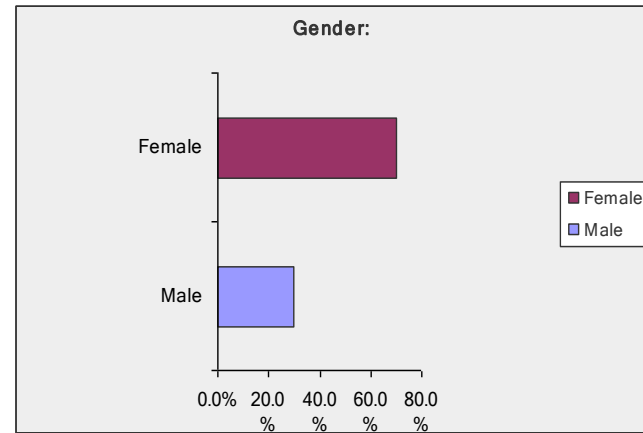

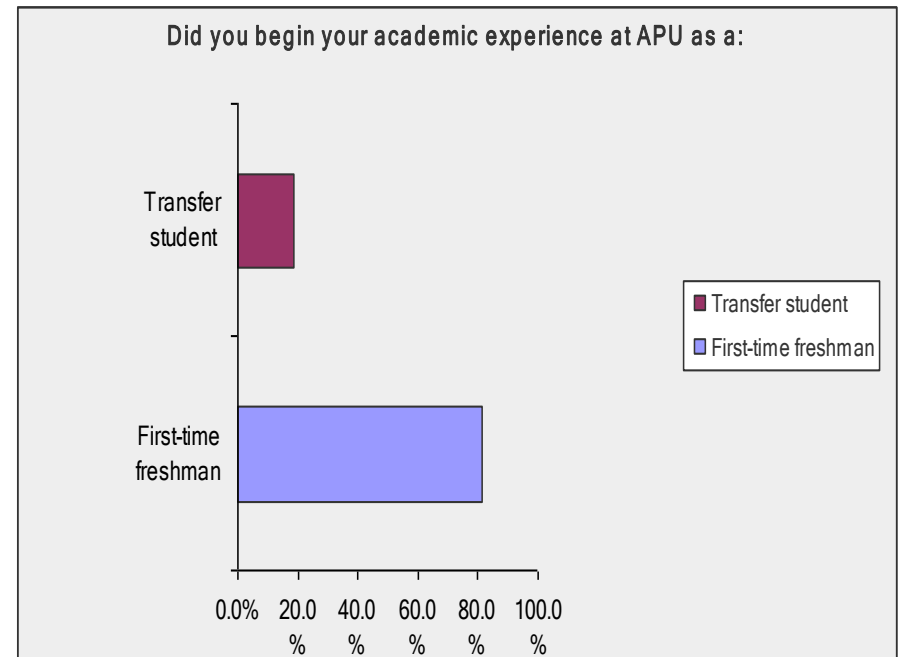

# How Did You Begin your Academic Experience?

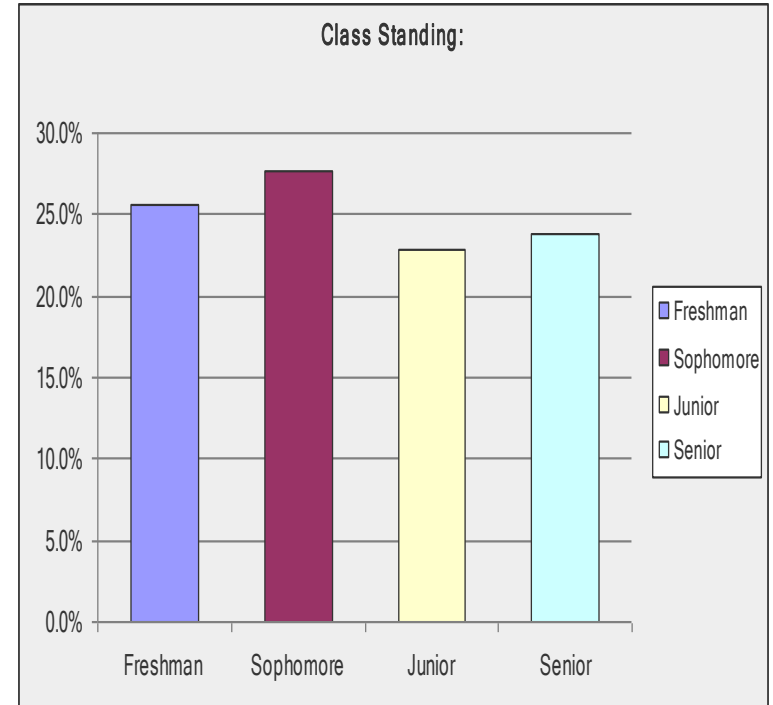

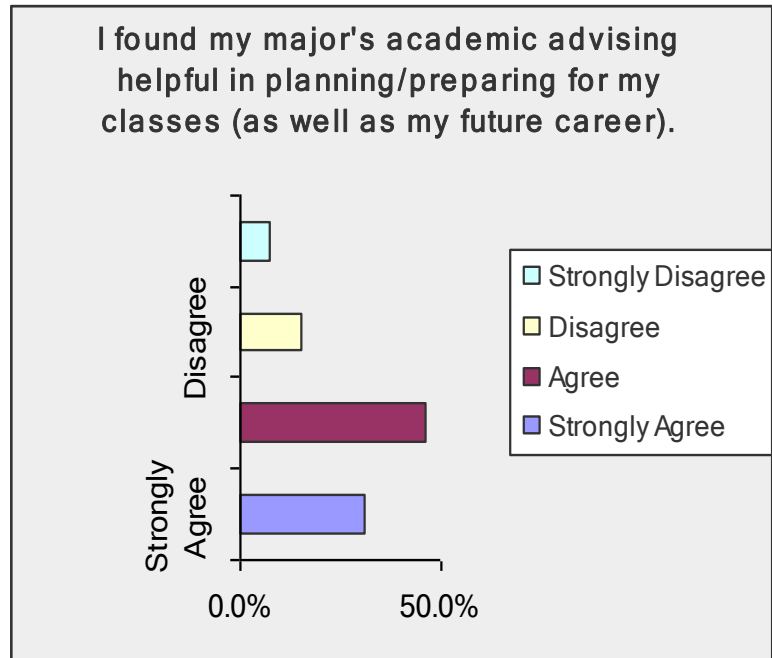

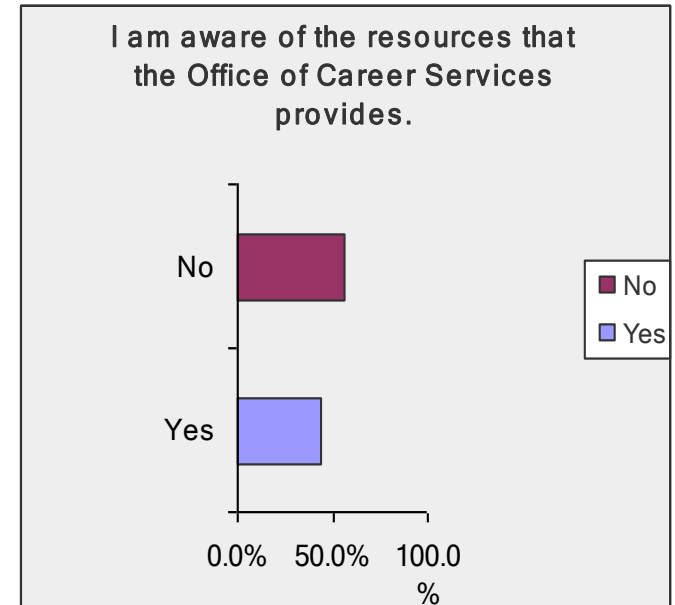

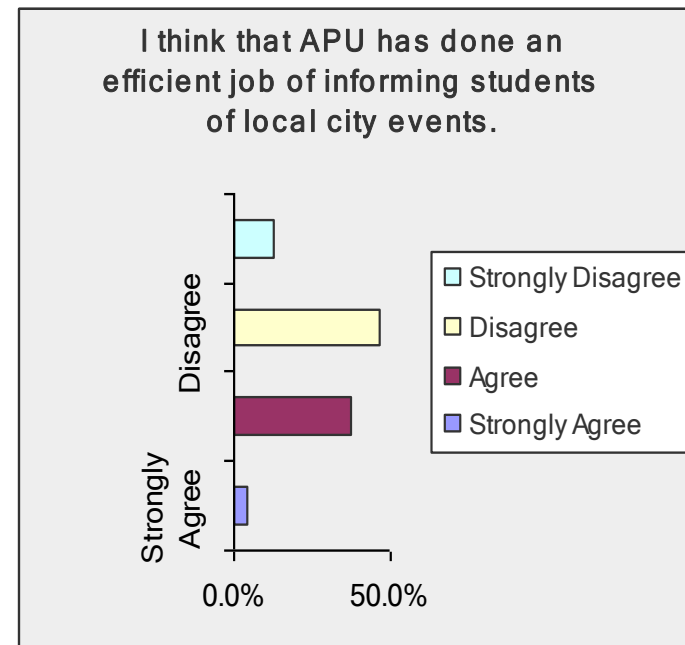

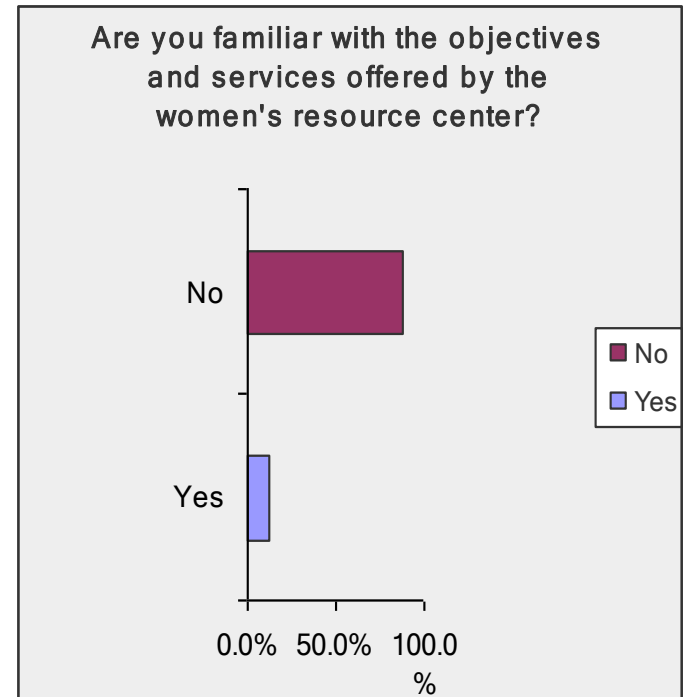

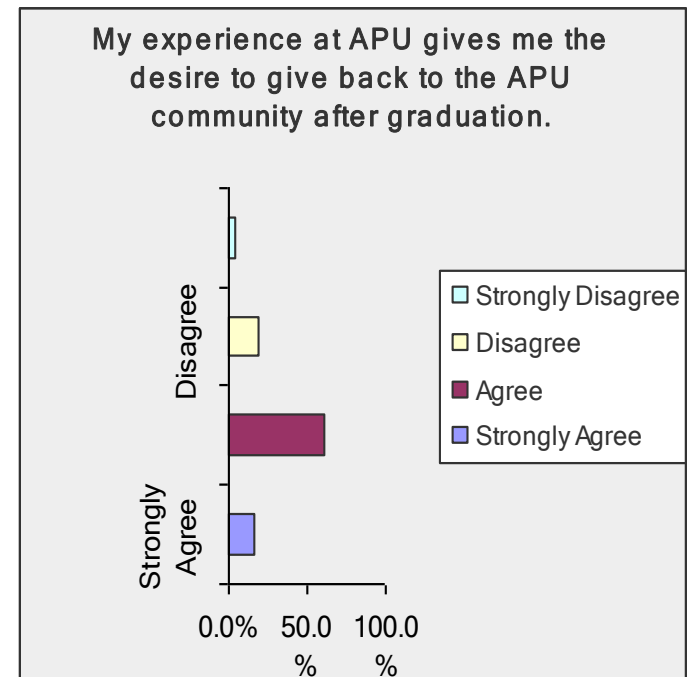

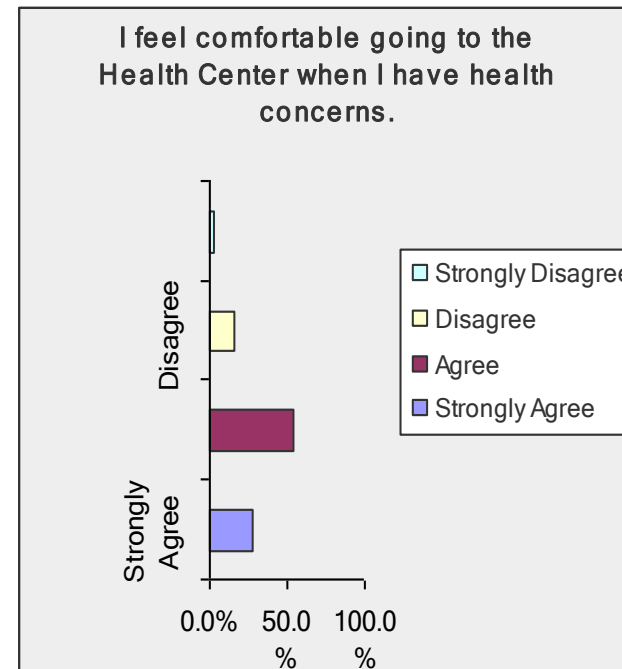

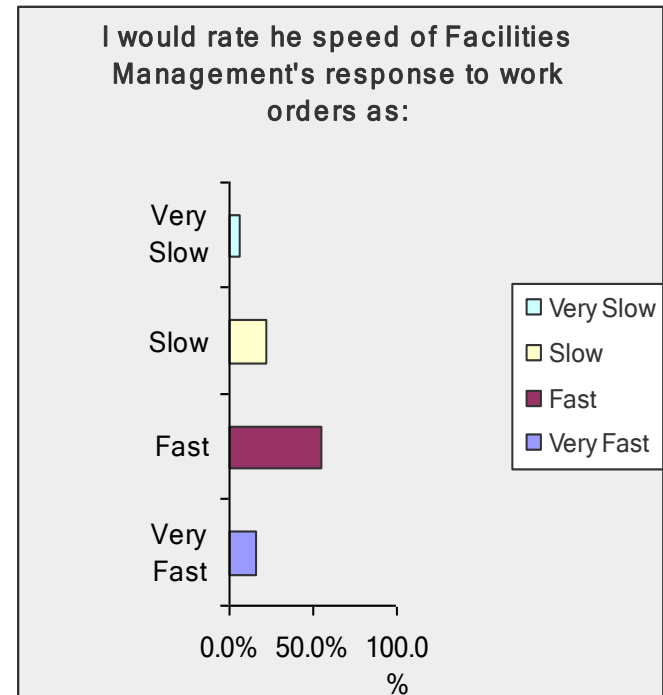
