1 **WHEREAS**, Krishna Bezwada has failed to attend the 9/4/14 and 8/16/14 Senate meetings in addition to
2 missing both days 8/16/14 , 8/17/14 of the fall retreat, and;

4 **WHEREAS**, the SG-UNO Bylaws, Article II, Section A, Clause 6, clearly establish, “Clause 6: Attendance of
5 each Student Senator shall be governed by the following SG-UNO policy:

- 6 a. Two (2) missed Student Senate sessions is cause for impeachment;
7 b. Two (2) missed Student Government Committee meetings are equivalent to two (2) missed Student
8 Senate Session;

10 **WHEREAS**, the SG-UNO Constitution clearly states,
11 “Article V, Section III-REMOVAL BY IMPEACHMENT

12 A. Officers Subject to Removal by Impeachment

13 The President/Regent, Vice President, Student Senators, and/or Student Court Justices may be
14 removed from office by conviction of malfeasance in office and/or misfeasance in office as a
15 result of an impeachment trial.

16 B. Causes for Impeachment-

- 17 1. Malfeasance in office defined as: the commission of a wrongful act. Wrongful act shall
18 mean a serious criminal offense or student misconduct in violation of the UNO Student
19 Code of Conduct.
20 2. Non-feasance in office defined as: the failure to perform official duties and responsibilities.

22 **WHEREAS**, the 2014 resolution, Attendance at Fall Retreat, states that “absence at the fall retreat will result in
23 2.0 points.”
24

25 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Krishna Bezwada should be removed from office in accordance with
26 attendance requirements established in the SG-UNO Bylaws and the definition of “misfeasance in office”
27 prescribed in the SG-UNO Constitution
