Student Senate Cross-Cultural Experience Scholarship Application

The Cross-Cultural Experience (CCE) Scholarship is a \$500 scholarship awarded to ten undergraduate students in at least their second year who have demonstrated leadership and academic achievements in the Carroll University community. An individual can only receive this scholarship once and it is for credit earned courses only. A student will only receive the scholarship funds once he/she has been accepted into the academic program for which the scholarship would be used. The information on this application as well as CCE approval status will be confirmed by the Office of International Education. A selection committee of faculty, staff, and eligible senators will decide the recipients. If a student receives one of the ten scholarships then he/she must make a presentation to the Carroll University Student Senate within one month of their return/completion (i.e. September for Summer travels, January for Winter travels, etc.)
