## **Description of Position:**

### Process to be Appointed:

Step 1: Complete application > Step 2: Attend the next regularly scheduled ASUCCC Board meeting (Thursdays 3pm) > Step 3: Participate in the 30-day probation period > Step 4: Meet with ASUCCC Screening Committee

### **Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Attend ASU Board Meetings: It is required that you are on time and attend all ASUCCC Board meetings. If you miss meetings it will make it impossible to effectively represent CCC students.
- Attend Meetings: It is important that you attend all of your committee meetings. If you miss a meeting it makes it difficult for the group to get the work done, and it will put you behind and make it harder for you to contribute in the future. Some committees only meet once a month, so it is important that you go regularly.
