Admission to the Student Legal Services Internship is with the Director's permission only

REQUIREMENTS

Full-time Juniors and Seniors only. A completed Application, a passing Interview and a 2.5 GPA; successful completion of RCRJ 425 (Criminal Procedure) or RCRJ 424 (Substantive Criminal Law) before or during the Fall 2015 or Spring 2016 semesters.

OBJECTIVE

Students develop legal skills (initial case development, client interviewing) and gain practical knowledge of the legal system and law practice other than private practice.

CREDIT

RCRJ 423 (Student Legal Services Internship) extends from the Fall 2015 semester through Spring 2016 semester but Interns register for RCRJ 423 (Student Legal Services Internship) in the Spring 2016 semester. RCRJ425 and 424 are 3-4 credits and RCRJ 423 is 4 credits. The credits and grade for RCRJ 423 will reflect work for the entire academic year. Besides office work RCRJ 423 includes mandatory training sessions, mandatory law seminars, a Court Visit assignment, and an Exam. Mandatory training sessions and mandatory law seminars are held evenings - time and place TBA. Grading for RCRJ 423 is A - E.

ACTIVITIES

Five (5) hours office per week including new client Interviews, client counseling and contact, and general office work. All required activities are outlined in the Student Legal Services OfficeBook. The Director will create shifts commencing early September 2015 after students submit ten (10 - Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) available hours.
