

Student Organization Levels

Implemented for 2009-2010

Level 1 (Required for all social fraternities and sororities)

- The President of the organization is required to attend the monthly President's Circle meeting led by the Student Government Association
- 3 members are required to attend 4 out of 7 monthly leadership series events sponsored by the Student Government Association
- Must have an updated constitution in the Office of Student Activities and keep organization's information up to date through Club Manager through the Student Organizations website.
- Must have a Faculty/Staff advisor
- Must check the organization's mailbox at least once per week
- Must follow the Office of Student Activities event registration and posting policies
- May have access to the resources in the Office of Student Activities (copy machine, butcher paper, markers, etc.)
- May participate in Blast Off and Clubfest sponsored by the Office of Student Activities.
- Eligible to receive funding throughout the year from the Finance Allocation Board through the Student Government Association

Level 2

- The President of the organization is required to attend the monthly President's Circle meeting led by the Student Government Association
- 3 members are required to attend 2 out of 7 monthly leadership series events sponsored by the Student Government Association
- Must have an updated constitution in the Office of Student Activities and keep organization's information up to date through Club Manager through the Student Organizations website.
- Must have a Faculty/Staff advisor
- Must check the organization's mailbox at least once per week.
- Must follow the Office of Student Activities event registration and posting policies
- May participate in Blast Off and Clubfest sponsored by the Office of Student Activities
- Eligible to receive Base Allocation from the Student Government Association
- Eligible to receive funding once a semester from the Finance Allocation Board through the Student Government Association.

Level 3

- The President of the organization is not required to attend the monthly President's Circle meeting

- Must have an updated constitution in the Office of Student Activities and keep organization's information up to date through Club Manager through the Student Organizations website
- Must have a Faculty/Staff advisor
- Must check the organization's mailbox at least once per week
- Must follow the Office of Student Activities event registration and posting policies
- May participate in Blast Off and Clubfest sponsored by the Office of Student Activities
- Not eligible for receive funding throughout the year from the Finance Allocation Board through the Student Government Association
- Not required to attend the monthly leadership series sponsored by the Student Government Association

Campus Ministries

- The President of the organization is required to attend the monthly President's Circle meeting and the Campus Ministries Council meeting.
- Receive base allocation from the Chaplain's Office
- Eligible to receive funding once a semester from the Finance Allocation Board through the Student Government Association
- The organization is not required to attend the monthly leadership series sponsored by the Student Government Association
- Must have an updated constitution in the Office of Student Activities and keep organization's information up to date through Club Manager through the Student Organizations website
- Must have a Faculty/Staff advisor
- Must check the organization's mailbox at least once per week.
- Must follow the Office of Student Activities event registration and posting policies
- May participate in Blast Off and Clubfest sponsored by the Office of Student Activities
