Online Application Instructions

Application Process:

- To apply as a candidate for any of the available positions, visit www.miami.edu/sg and follow the instructions under the “Get Involved” section. Paper applications for candidacy will not be made available or accepted. Please note that although all student government positions are listed on the electronic application form, **ONLY THOSE LISTED IN THIS APPLICATION** packet are available. **FILING FOR CANDIDACY ENDS AT 5PM, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2012. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- The Mandatory Referenda Writing Workshop and optional Candidate Informational Meetings are scheduled for **Monday, January 30, 2012 and Tuesday, January 31 at 8:30pm and 9:00pm respectively** in room UC211 on the second floor of the University Center. Anyone submitting referenda MUST attend the workshop.
- The Mandatory Candidates’ and Referenda Sponsors’ meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday, February 8th, 2012 at 9:15pm** in the University Center, Flamingo Ballroom D. **FAILURE TO ATTEND THIS MEETING WITHOUT A PRIOR APPROVAL BY DR. BRIAN OREFICE, DIRECTOR OF ORIENTATION AND COMMUTER STUDENT INVOLVEMENT, STUDENT GOVERNMENT ADVISOR (UC 236) WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.**
- It is important that all candidates frequently check their email and immediately respond to inquiries made by the Elections Commission. The Commission will use email as the primary source of communicating elections updates, hearing information etc. to all candidates.
- All forms referenced on the Fall Election Calendar (the **Graphic Campaign Approval Form**, the **General Election Financial Reports**, and the **Request for Review Form**) are also available on-line through the MyUM Groups system (system used for filing for candidacy).
- Candidates may withdraw their names at any time prior to the announcement of the official results of the election. This must be done in written form and submitted, in person or via email, to the Student Government Advisor, Dr. Brian Orefice, at borefice@miami.edu. Any candidacy withdrawn after the application deadline may not be re-instated. However, the candidate may be eligible to run as a write-in candidate.
