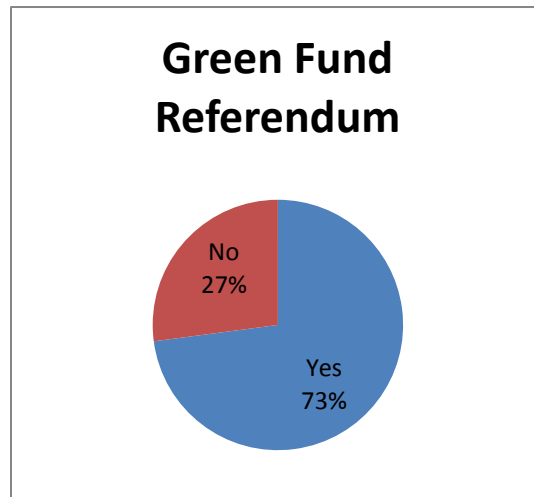

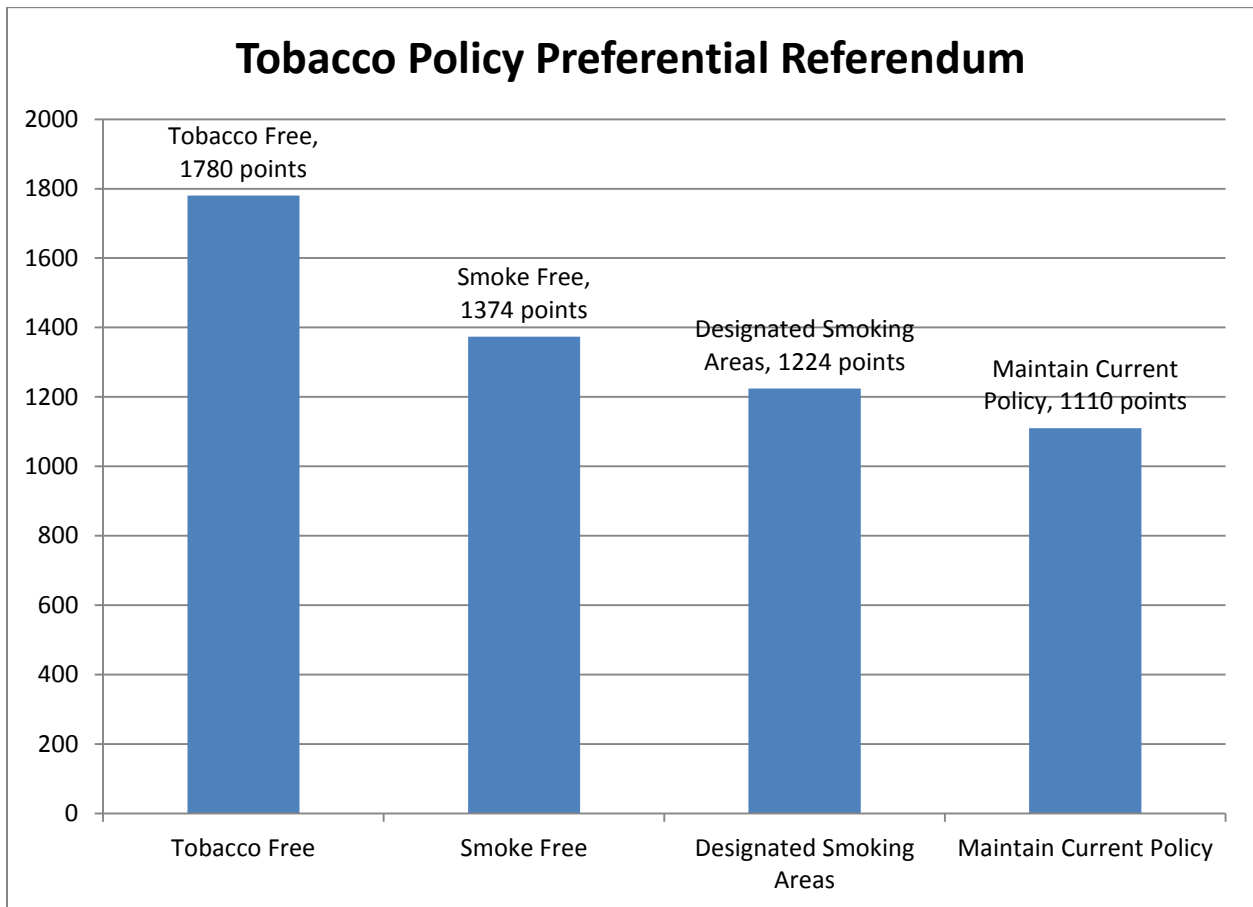
2. Do you support the creation of a "Green Fund" on campus, dedicated to funding capital projects for sustainability, through \$12 a year in segregated fees?
