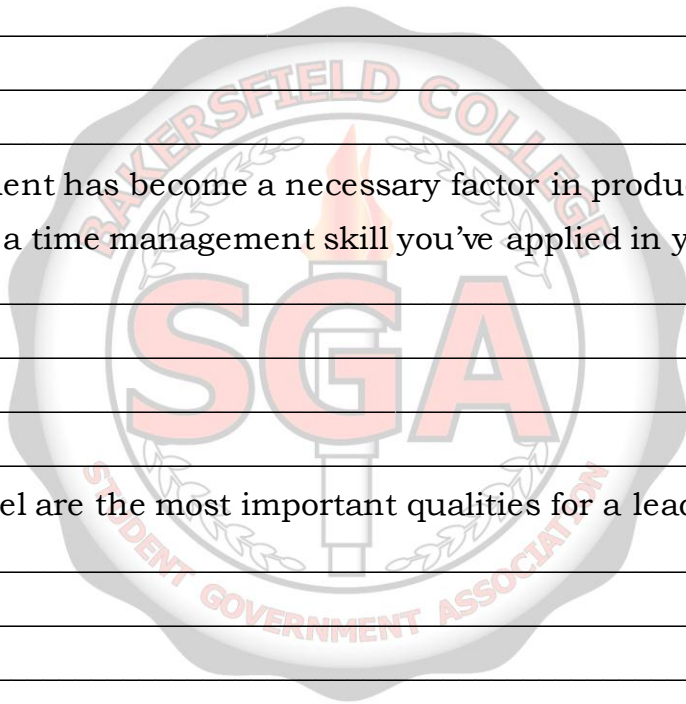

SGA/CAMPUS WIDE COMMITTEES

Communications Committee includes the Secretary (chair), no more than three (3) senators and no more than two (2) commissioners at large. Additional members may be added should the need arise at the discretion of the chair.

Legislative Affairs Committee includes legislative liaison (chair), General Counsel (co-chair), and at least two (2) Representatives. Additional Members may be added should the need arise at the discretion of the chair.

Finance Committee includes the treasurer (chair), no more than two (2) representatives, and no more than two (2) commissioners at large. Additional members may be added should the need arise at the discretion of the chair.

Activities Board includes the Activities Liaison (chair), one club representative from each club and as many representatives and commissioners at large as deemed fit.

Academic Senate- to represent the faculty to the administration and to the Board of Trustees and make recommendations with respect to academic and professional matters outside the scope of the bargaining unit. - includes one SGA rep

Budget Subcommittee- communicates with College Council- includes one SGA rep

Committee on Committees- to review any requests to create a new campus- wide committee or project team, to eliminate duplication of effort, and to annually evaluate the effectiveness of each committee and make recommendations for continuation/alteration/discontinuation to the President. - includes one SGA rep

College Council- addresses college-wide issues through a collaborative, integrative approach, promoting greater communication that is accessible to the college campus at large, and to facilitate timely and effectively description-making efforts. – includes 2 SGA reps

Curriculum- to ensure that the curriculum is consistent with the mission of the college, addresses the needs of students and the community, and meets the requirements of law and regulations. - includes one SGA rep

Enrollment Management- to develop a process for establishing enrollment goals, the specific action to be taken in order to attain those goals and to monitor progress on reaching them with a focus on growth, retention, and outreach. - includes one SGA rep

Equal Opportunity Advisory Committee- to educate and orient the college on diversity issues and concerns and to assist the Affirmative Action Officer in helping the college to achieve and maintain its hiring goal of having a diverse staff and faculty who mirror the communities that the college serves.-includes one SGA rep

Facilities Planning Committee- To review and/ or provide recommendation for new and improved facilities and infrastructure to enhance current and future learning environments for students, community, faculty, and staff to the College Council.-includes one SGA rep

Gen Ed- communicates with Curriculum Committee and the VP Student Learning.- includes one SGA rep

Information System and Instructional Technology includes two SGA representatives.

Matriculation Advisory- Communicates with the VP Student Services and Academic Senate.- includes one SGA rep

Safety- To identify problems and issues on campus and resolve them, inform the campus community of new policies and procedures as they relate to safety on campus, and develop and maintain current emergency evacuation maps. -includes one SGA rep
